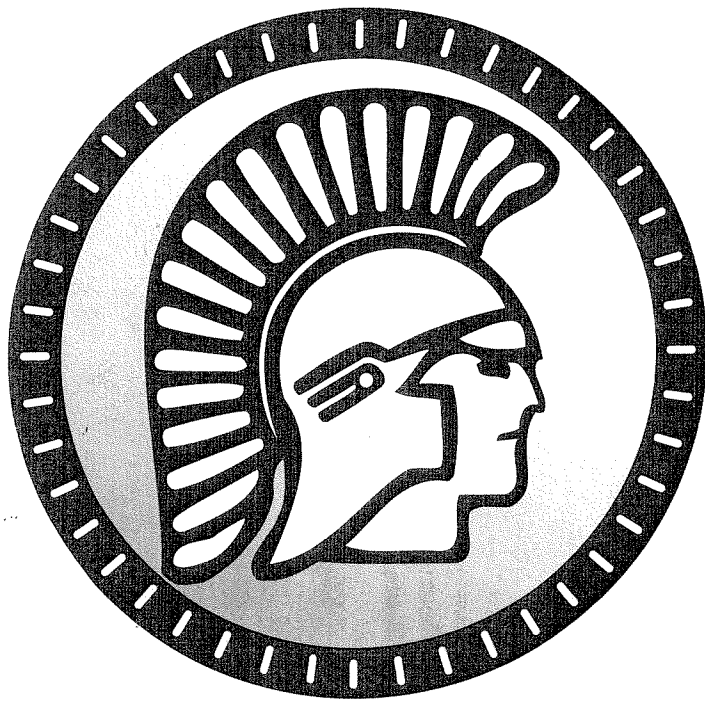

ANDREW PEARL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Andrew Pearl was a former teacher and high school principal at Greene Central from 1945 to 1965. He went on to become a nationally recognized educator. Mr. Pearl obtained his education by his own efforts. He was urged to go to college and was given a small start by a local philanthropist. From this encouragement developed his philosophy of "Extend a helping hand whenever and wherever possible." The recipient of this scholarship has demonstrated the characteristics which Andrew Pearl's life showed — need, scholarship, service, citizenship and initiative.
